POSITION TITLE	DESCRIPTION
Youth Mentors (Girls/Boys)	EFCS mentors serve as individuals who want to have a positive impact on young adults' lives. He/she is a trusted person who is caring and provides positive solutions and support.  Mentors provide access to people, places, and things outside the mentee's daily routine and environment. The mentor uses a Life Plan, a written statement of the goals of the youth, as an ongoing touch point for mentoring relationships with our youth.
	Commitment: Meet in-person or virtual with assigned mentee(s) for a minimum of four (4) hours per month during weekly program sessions. Additional contact each month by phone or e-mail is also allowed, as needed.
Guest Speakers	Guest speakers participate in designated workshops to speak on topics to support youth or adult program participants. Topics include but are not limited to career panel discussions or events, wellness, financial management, civic engagement, etc.
	Commitment: 30-45 minutes for speaking engagements or events
Distribution Associates	Distribution associates assist in organizing or distributing items for/to schools, local community centers and clients in the community who have transportation barriers.
	Commitment: 2-4 hours monthly
Volunteer Assistant	EFCS Volunteer assistants support the volunteer team in making calls or sending communications to previous or new volunteers; organizing volunteer folders.

	Commitment: 2-4 hours monthly
Social Media Ambassadors	Social Media Ambassadors help in promoting events, activities, programs and services on social media, spreading the word about the organization's mission and ways that others can support our efforts.
	Commitment: 1 hour weekly
Tutors (Middle/High School)	Tutors will assist middle/high school students who may be struggling in core curriculum areas (ELA, Math, Science and/or Social Studies).
	They are responsible for helping students learn and understand new concepts and complete assignments. The assigned tutor will review lessons and textbooks/materials in detail to understand the topic they will be supporting and assist with projects if needed during a session.
	Commitment: 1 day weekly for 2 hours
